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**THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974**

(Ordinances 11 of 1974, 1 of 1982 and 3 of 1985).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974 the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Acting Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue turtle-doves, wood-pigeons, rock-pigeons, sparrows, crows, magpies and foxes, in the areas set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on the 20th April, 1986 and ending on the 11th May, 1986 subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) shooting shall take place between sunrise and sunset only ;
- (b) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any Service installations or within 100 yards of the perimeter fence of the RAF Station Akrotiri ;
- (c) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (d) there shall be no shooting within 200 yards of any village built-up area or in any private fenced up land ;
- (e) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (f) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun ;
- (g) no dogs shall be allowed.

SCHEDULE

AREA 'A'

This area will remain closed.

AREA 'B'

All that area which lies west of the Kouris river, bounded to the south by the sea, to the west by Curium beach track and to the north by the SBA boundary. This area extends to the east of Kouris river and covers, south of M.1, an area in the form of a triangle, bounded on one side by the river, on another by the coast and on the third side by the track which demarcates the Game Reserve Area (Ayios Demetrianos Locality). North of M. 1 this area includes certain areas on the east bank of the river which are bare of permanent plantations, plus the locality known as Vounarkotissa, commencing 100 yards north of M. 1 and the locality known as Terratches tou Hadjipavlou, all of which are properly signposted on the ground.

AREA 'C'

All that area which lies south of Limassol - Ypsonas road, commencing from boundary pillar 188 and ending at boundary pillar 146; thence the boundary runs due south along the Sovereign Base Area boundaries up to the junction of the Trakhoni - Kolossi link road on the main Phassouri - Kolossi road; thence along the former road up to boundary pillar 201, excluding any game reserves and certain lands which lie between the two main earth tracks which branch off the old Kolossi-Zakaki road and converge on a track south of the Ypsonas - Kolossi main road, the area banned for shooting in this particular pocket of lands having been properly signposted on the ground.

THE MINIMUM WAGE ORDINANCE

(Cap. 183—Laws of Cyprus).

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER
SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Section 3 of the Minimum Wage Ordinance, the Administrator hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Salaries (Shop Assistants and Clerks) Order, 1986.

2. In this Order unless the context otherwise requires:—

“Clerk” means any person performing clerical tasks, including the conducting of correspondence, the drafting of letters, the assembling and presentation of information, the preparation and issuing of receipts, the recording of entries in books, the filling in of forms, the handling of telephones, calculating and cash registering machines and general registry duties;

“Shop Assistant” means any person who is principally engaged in the selling of goods or articles in a retail establishment but does not include any employee in a catering establishment or any person whose relationship with the employer is that of a husband, wife, father, mother, son or daughter.

3.—(1) Subject to the provisions of sub-paragraph (2) of this paragraph the minimum monthly salary to be paid to any Clerk or Shop Assistant in the Areas from the 1st March, 1986, shall be one hundred and two pounds.

(2) (a) The minimum monthly salary to be paid to any Clerk or Shop Assistant in the Areas who, before the 1st March, 1986 had completed six months continuous employment with the same employer shall as from the 1st March, 1986 be one hundred and eleven pounds.

(b) The minimum monthly salary to be paid to any Clerk or Shop Assistant who will have completed six months continuous employment with the same employer at any time after the 1st March, 1986 shall, as from the date of such completion of employment, be one hundred and eleven pounds:

Provided that any break in employment which under Part II of the Second Schedule of the Termination of Employment Ordinance is not a break in employment, shall not be deemed for the purposes of this sub-paragraph as a break in employment.

4. The minimum Salaries (Shop Assistants and Clerks) Order, 1984 is hereby revoked with effect from 1st March, 1986.

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL
POWERS) (CONTINUATION) ORDINANCE

(Cap. 175A—Laws of Cyprus).

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL
POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY
UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 63.

Whereas by Order dated the 15th May, 1984 and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 18th May, 1984 under Notification No. 36 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), the Competent Authority authorised the use, for the purpose of setting up a temporary graveyard of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated at Paramali village within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of two years ;

And whereas the Competent Authority is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for the said purpose for a further period of two years ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 63, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (as applied and adapted in the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia Order in Council, 1960 and the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) (Consolidation and Extension) Ordinance, which Order continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Ordinance, the Competent Authority has authorised the use of the said land for the purpose of setting up and maintaining a temporary graveyard, subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the Order for a further period of two years, as from the 25th May, 1986.
