THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinances 11 of 1974, 1 of 1982 and 3 of 1985).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby amends Public Instrument No. 76 of 1986 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Sovereign Base Areas Gazette No. 754 of 10th October, 1986 by repealing the Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the new Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto:—

APPENDIX

“ SCHEDULE

AREA ‘A’

(i) Upper Marsh Area :

This area includes the tarmac road which runs north of Upper marsh, as well as a 15 metre strip to the south of that tarmac road, as signposted on the ground.

(ii) North Salt Lake area :

This area begins at the point where the Forest Plantation Nursery Garden track meets the Kolossi - Akrotiri main road; thence in an easterly direction along the forest boundary to B.P. 242; thence further east along the SBA boundary to the junction which branches off to the Zakaki football ground, between B.Ps 265 and 266; thence south along that track to the coast of the lake, west of BEMRS; thence in a northerly and westerly directions, along the coast of the lake, to the point where the canal dividing Kanneri locality flows into the lake; thence in a northwesterly direction along that canal and the Forest Plantation track to the point of commencement. All which area is properly signposted on the ground.

AREA ‘B’

All that area which lies west of the Kouris river, bounded to the south by the sea, to the west by Curium beach track and to the north by the SBA boundary. This area extends to the east of Kouris river and covers, south of M.1, an area in the form of a triangle, bounded on one side by the river, on another by the coast and on the third side by the track which demarcates the Game Reserve Area (Ayios Demetrianos Locality). North of M. 1 this area includes certain areas on the east bank of the river which are bare of permanent plantations, plus the locality known as Vounarkotissa, commencing 100 metres north of M. 1 and the locality known as Terratches tou Hadjipavlou, all of which are properly signposted on the ground.

AREA 'C'

All that area which lies south of Limassol - Ypsonas road, commencing from boundary pillar 188 and ending at boundary pillar 146; thence the boundary runs due south along the Sovereign Base Area boundaries up to the junction of the Trakhoni - Kolossi link road on the main Phassouri - Kolossi road; thence along the former road up to boundary pillar 201, excluding any game reserves and certain lands which lie between the two main earth tracks which branch off the old Kolossi-Zakaki road and converge on a track south of the Ypsonas - Kolossi main road, the area banned for shooting in this particular pocket of lands having been properly signposted on the ground."

THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

(Ordinances 11 of 1974, 1 of 1982 and 3 of 1985).

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 27 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of Section 27 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, the Area Officer Akrotiri, with the approval of the Chief Officer, hereby authorises any holder of a valid game licence to shoot, take or pursue wild birds or foxes, in the area set out in the Schedule hereto during the period commencing on Sunday 4th January, 1987 and ending on Sunday 8th March, 1987, subject to the following terms and conditions :—

- (a) shooting shall take place on Sundays and Wednesdays only;
- (b) no dogs shall be used ;
- (c) no fires shall be kindled ;
- (d) no farm or other cultivated land where there is a risk of damage being caused to fruit trees, vegetable gardens, citrus plantations, cereal crops or vineyards shall be entered ;
- (e) shot-guns shall be carried from and to the areas specified in this notice dismantled ;
- (f) hunters shall carry with them their game licence, their gun possession licence and the certificate of registration of their gun.

2. This notice may be revoked at any time.

SCHEDULE

All those areas of Episkopi, Sotira and Paramali villages in so far as they lie within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Areas excluding any Game Reserves published in the Gazette and marked on the ground by appropriate signposts.
