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THE EXPLOSIVE SUBSTANCES ORDINANCE

(Cap. 54 — Laws of Cyprus — Ordinances 8 of 1970
and 9 of 1984.

**REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR
UNDER SECTION 13.**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 13 of the Explosive Substances Ordinance and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Explosive Substances (Amendment) Regulations, 1987 and shall be read as one with the Explosive Substances Regulations, 1940 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”).

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting the Second Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the following new Second Schedule :—

A Certificate of Competency issued under paragraph 3 and each licence issued or renewed under paragraphs 4 (c), 4 (d), 5 (c), 6 (b), 8, 10 (a), 10 (b) and 11 shall expire on the 31st day of December following the date of issue."

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Public Instrument No. 40 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 715 of 26th July, 1985 notice is hereby given that the following easements are required for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

Rights, easements, privileges and liberties for the purpose of and in connection with the laying, using and maintaining freely and uninterruptedly by the Acquiring Authority of a water pipeline in, over or under the following privately-owned immovable property within the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia in the village Pyla of Larnaca District and in relation to plot Nos. 146/1 (part), 126 (part), 125/1/1 (part) of the Government Survey Plan XLI.19.

**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL
 POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY
 UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 63.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 63, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, (as applied to and adapted in the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia Order in Council 1960 and the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) (Consolidation and Extension) Ordinance, 1968) which Order continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Ordinance, the Competent Authority hereby makes the following Order :—

1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for the purposes of constructing the Southern Conveyor through the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area, of the land and property specified in the Second Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during a period of one year as from the 26th of May, 1987 is hereby authorised.

2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purposes referred to in paragraph 1.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person whether by virtue of any interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

4. Public Instrument No. 52 of 1986 is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

FIRST SCHEDULE

1. The land shall be occupied and used for the purpose of constructing the Southern Conveyor through the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area.

2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be returned to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.

3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest in the land for its use and occupation under this Order.
