## THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Public Instrument No. 60 of 1990 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 897 of the 3rd July, 1990, notice is hereby given that the following private immovable property is required for the undertaking of the public utility mentioned therein.

The private immovable property, within the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia, in the Village area of Xylotymbou, Larnaca District, under and in connection with plots Nos. 9 (part), 5 (part), of the Government Survey Plan XXXII.61.W1, Plots Nos. 270 (part), 269 (part), 268/2 (part) and 267/1 (part) of the Government Survey Plan XXXII.61W2.

The land area of the above immovable property comprises 745 square metres or thereabouts and is coloured red on the relative plan kept at the office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration of Dhekelia.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 15  
OF THE PRISONS ORDINANCE READ WITH SECTION 11  
OF THE PRISONS ORDINANCE AND WITH SECTION 9  
OF THE POLICE ORDINANCE.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by subsection (2) of Section 15 of the Prisons Ordinance, 1971 read with Section 11 of that Ordinance and with Section 9 of the Police Ordinance, 1967, I, the Superintendent of Prisons and the Chief Police Officer, with the approval of the Administrator, do hereby make the following Regulations: —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police and Prison Officers (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990 and shall be read as one with the Police and Prison Officers (Pensions) Regulations as amended by the Police and Prison Officers (Pensions) (Amendment) Regulations, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”).

2. Regulation 20 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended —

- (1) by deleting the comma at the end of paragraph (b) of Section 20 thereof and substituting therefor a colon followed by the word “or” and
- (2) by adding the following new paragraph to be lettered (c) : —  
“(c) the balance of any bank loan made to a Sovereign Base Areas Police Officer under arrangements sponsored by the SBA Administration.”.

## THE POLICE ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 9 of 1967, 14 of 1969 and 7 of 1975).

**ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 23 (1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 23 (1) of the Police Ordinance, I hereby order that Waterloo Road South, from its eastern junction with the Larnaca/Famagusta Road to its junction with the Ormedhia/Dhekelia Road, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic, except for access, from 0800 to 1200 hours on 19th July, 1990. During this period, vehicular traffic will be diverted around Dhekelia Garrison via Larnaca/Famagusta Road and Waterloo Road North.
