**ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 30.**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 30 of the Game and Wild Birds (Protection and Development) Ordinance, 1974, I, the Chief Officer, hereby declare the whole of Dhekalia Sovereign Base Area (other than the area already declared, as a Game Reserve under Public Instrument No. 58 of 1969) to be a temporary Game Reserve for the period beginning on the 1st January, 1996 and ending on the 31st December, 1996.

THE SAFETY AT PLACES OF WORK ORDINANCE  
(Ordinance 1 of 1989)

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (1)

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto, of the following new "specified establishment" to be numbered 8 :-

"8. Installations which store petroleum products and bottled liquid gas."

**THE COMMODITIES AND SERVICES (REGULATION AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE.**

(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963, 3 of 1967, 10 of 1972, 10 of 1982 and 6 of 1995).

**CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4(1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, 1962 the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of EDAM Cheese) Order, 1996.
2. Locally produced Edam cheese is hereby declared to be a controlled commodity for the purposes of this Ordinance.
3. The prices at which locally produced cheese of the EDAM type is sold in the Areas shall not exceed the maximum wholesale and retail prices set out in the second and third columns respectively of the Schedule hereto.
4. Public Instrument No. 74 of 1995 is hereby revoked.
