**THE POWERBOATS ORDINANCE**  
(Ordinances 8 of 1999 and 5 of 2001)

---

**REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 22.**

---

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 22 of the Powerboats Ordinance 1999 the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Powerboats (Temporary Provisions) Regulations 2001.

2. Pending the conclusion of satisfactory arrangements between the Authorities of the Republic of Cyprus and the Sovereign Base Areas Administration, for the reciprocal recognition of licences, as defined in the principal Ordinance, the following exemptions shall apply:-

- (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3(1) of the principal Ordinance the following persons may operate a powerboat within the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas:-
- (1) Any person under the age of eighteen years providing he is in possession of a learner's licence as defined in the principal Ordinance and is accompanied by a person over the age of eighteen years who is holder of a valid operator's licence as so defined, and
  - (2) Any member of Her Majesty's Forces or any Police Officer when in the course of his duties is operating any vessel owned by the Crown in any capacity.
- (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 7A of the principal Ordinance, the following owners of vessels operating within the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas shall be exempt from the requirements to hold a circulation licence as defined in the said Ordinance:-
- (1) the Crown in any capacity whilst such vessel is employed on official duties,
  - (2) the commodores or officers in charge of any Water Sports Club operating under the auspices of the Royal Yachting Association or otherwise sponsored by the Service Authorities, in relation to the use of vessels owned by that Club and operated for the purposes of the Club, and
  - (3) the owners of any private craft registered within the Sovereign Base Areas under the provisions of the Emergency Powers (Control of Small Vessels) Regulations 1955 and bearing the prefix "AK" (Akrotiri) or "DK" (Dhekelia).

Whereas by Order dated the 6th May, 1997 published in Supplement No.3 to the Gazette of the 6th May, 1997 under Notification No. 25 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), the Administrator authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of two years;

And whereas by virtue of Notification No.17 published in Supplement No.3 to the Gazette of the 22nd March 1999, the Order was extended for a further period of two years;

And whereas the Administrator is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of two years;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order 1946, (as applied to and adapted in the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia Order in Council, 1960, and the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) (Consolidation and Extension) Ordinance, which Order continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Ordinance, the Administrator has authorised the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of two years as from the 6th May 2001.
