THE POWERS AND DUTIES (OFFICERS OF THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE 1976
(Ordinance 4 of 1976).

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3 of the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) Ordinance 1976 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order 2001 and shall be read as one with the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) Order 1976 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

THE POWERBOATS ORDINANCE
(Ordinances 8 of 1999 and 5 of 2001)

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 22.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 22 of the Powerboats Ordinance 1999 the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Powerboats (Restriction on the Use of Jet Skis) Regulations 2001.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:-

“jet ski” means a small powerboat propelled by an outboard or inboard waterjet propulsion system.

3. The use of jet skis at a distance of more than 700 metres from the coastline is hereby prohibited.

4. Except when travelling through a channel specifically demarcated for the passage of boats, as provided for in the Sea Bathers (Protection) Ordinance, the use of jet skis at a distance of less than 100 metres from any area demarcated by buoys as being reserved for the use of swimmers, under the provisions of the Sea Bathers (Protection) Ordinance is hereby prohibited.

5. It is prohibited for any jet ski leaving or approaching the coastline to travel at more than three knots in the following circumstances:-

- (a) when travelling through a channel specifically demarcated for the passage of boats, as provided for in the Sea Bathers (Protection) Ordinance; or
- (b) in any other circumstances when within 100 metres of the coastline.

2. The use of jet skis is further restricted under the following circumstances:-

- (a) during the period 1st May to 30th September each year when within 500 metres of the coastline the use of jet skis is prohibited between the following times:-
 - (i) Sunrise to 10.00 a.m.;
 - (ii) 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.; and
 - (iii) after sunset.
- (b) during the period 1st October to 30th April each year the use of jet skis is prohibited before sunrise and after sunset.
- (c) the use of jet skis is prohibited at all times when –
 - (1) there are rough seas;
 - (2) the wind speed exceeds 16 knots; and
 - (3) the visibility is less than one nautical mile.

7. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations commits an offence and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment not exceeding two years or to a fine not exceeding three thousand pounds or to both such penalties.
