THE POWERS AND DUTIES (OFFICERS OF THE REPUBLIC
OF CYPRUS) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE 1976
(Ordinance 4 of 1976).

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3 of the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) Ordinance 1976 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Special Provisions) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order 2001.

2. Subject to the restrictions and conditions specified in paragraph 3 of this Order, the powers and duties conferred or imposed by each of the enactments specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order upon the persons specified opposite thereto in the second column of the said Schedule (which said powers and duties are either directly or where Colonial titles are specified by virtue of the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) (Consolidation and Extension) Ordinance, conferred, or imposed upon Officers of the Areas) may be lawfully exercised or performed in or in relation to the Areas by any Officer of the Republic who under any law of the Republic for the time being in force is authorised or permitted to exercise or perform any power or duty in relation to the same matters or things as are dealt with by such enactment (hereinafter referred to as "the appropriate Republican officer"):

Provided that the powers set out in the said Schedule may only be exercised after consultation with the Officer of the Areas upon whom they are also conferred or imposed under the provisions of the enactment under which such powers and duties are to be exercised (hereinafter referred to as "the appropriate Officer of the Areas") and may not be exercised if the appropriate Officer of the Areas notifies the appropriate Republican Officer in writing that such exercise would be detrimental to military requirements or security needs, or would be contrary to the declared policy of Her Majesty's Government for the administration of the Sovereign Base Areas.

3. Nothing contained in this Order shall:-

- (a) be deemed to confer or impose any power or duty upon any member of the police force or the customs department of the Republic by whatever name such force or department may be known, or
- (b) confer or impose upon any Officer of the Republic any power or duty in relation to -
 - (i) the acts or omissions of any person employed in the service of Her Majesty, being acts or omissions done in or arising out of or in the course of such employment, or

- (ii) any property owned or occupied by the Crown or by an authorised Service organisation or any act or omission occurring on such property; so, however, that nothing in this sub-paragraph shall apply in relation to any property which is owned by the Crown in right only of its administration in the Areas and which is not occupied by the Crown in any capacity.

4. In this Order the expression "authorised Service organisation" means any organisation declared by the Administrator by notification in the Gazette to be an authorised Service organisation for the purposes of this Order.

OF CYPRUS) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE 1976
(Ordinance 4 of 1976).

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 10.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 10 of the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) Ordinance 1976 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) (Amendment of Schedule) Order 2001 and shall be read as one with the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) Ordinance 1976 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").
