**THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC
ORDINANCE**

(Ordinances 8 of 1973, 5 of 1982, 2 of 1983, 11 of 1985
and 5 of 1999).

ORDER MADE UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by subsection (2) of section 4 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance 1973, I, the Chief Officer, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Speed Limits (Amendment) Order 2002 and shall be read as one with the Speed Limits Order 1989 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. Paragraph (1) of Part II of the Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended to read as follows:

THE POWERBOATS ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 8 of 1999 as amended by Ordinances 5 of 2001
and 13 of 2001).

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 22.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 22 of the Powerboats Ordinance 1999^(a) as amended by section 5 of the Powerboats (Amendment) Ordinance 2001^(b), the Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Powerboats (Amendment) Regulations 2002.

Amendments to the Powerboats Regulations 2001^(c).

2. Regulation 22 of the Powerboats Regulations 2001 shall be amended as follows –

- (a) in paragraph (3) for the words “A person” there shall be substituted the words “Subject to paragraph (4) below, a person”;
- (b) after paragraph (3) there shall be added the following paragraph, to be numbered paragraph (4) –

“ (4) The restriction on using a jet ski between 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. imposed by sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (3) above does not apply where a jet ski is used at a distance of more than 500 metres from the nearest coast or where a jet ski is used at a distance of less than 500 metres from the nearest coast in order to enable the user of the jet ski to reach a place which is more than 500 metres from the nearest coast or to return to the coast from such a place.”.

THE POLICE ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 9 of 1967, 14 of 1969, 7 of 1975, 2 of 1993, 10 of 1998 and 25/99)

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 23(1)

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 23(1) of the Police Ordinance, I, the Acting Chief Constable, hereby order that Waterloo Road South from East to West roundabouts shall be closed to all vehicular traffic from 0900 hours to 1500 hours on Friday 26 July 2002. Traffic to Ayia Napa or Larnaca not using the new highway will be diverted via Snake Road.
