THE FORESHORE PROTECTION ORDINANCE

(Ordinance 9 of 1975, 9 of 1987, 12 of 1999 and 13 of 2003)

ORDER UNDER SECTION 5F(7)

Whereas the Episkopi Foreshore Committee, acting in accordance with the provisions of subsection (1) of Section 5F of The Foreshore Protection Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as “the Ordinance”), has prepared a plan of the foreshore within the administrative area of Episkopi village (“The Episkopi Foreshore Plan” hereinafter referred to as “the Plan”) showing—

- (a) The parts of the foreshore belonging to the Crown in right of its Administration of the Sovereign Base Areas;
- (b) The parts of the foreshore where it is proposed that sun beds, mattresses and beach umbrellas are to be provided for the use of the public, whether or not for consideration;

and has submitted the Plan to me for consideration;

And whereas I, acting in accordance with the provisions of subsection (2) of Section 5F of the Ordinance have approved, signed and deposited the Plan at the Area Office Akrotiri for inspection by any interested person;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, acting in accordance with the provisions of subsection (2) of Section 5F of the Ordinance has caused a Notice to be published in the Gazette No. 1325 of the 8th April 2004, in the form of Public Instrument No. 54 of 2004 (hereinafter referred to as “the Notice”), stating that the Plan had been approved by me and advising any person wishing to object to the Plan to do so in writing to me, within 3 weeks of the publication of the Notice stating the grounds of his objection;

And whereas, by the expiration of the objection period set out in the Notice, I had not received any objections to the approved Plan;

Now, therefore, I declare the Plan to be a finalised Plan in accordance with the provisions of subsection (7) of Section 5F of the Ordinance.
