**THE PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF GAME AND WILD BIRDS
ORDINANCE 2004**

(Ordinances 15 of 2004, 22 of 2005 and 1 of 2006)

ORDER UNDER SECTION 43

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 43 of The Protection and Management of Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2004, I hereby prescribe the areas defined in the Schedule here below to be temporary Game Reserves, for the corresponding periods specified therein.

SCHEDULE

S/N	Areas prescribed as Temporary Game Reserves	Period for which the prescription is valid
1.	<p>The whole of the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area excluding:-</p> <p>(i) The area contained within a boundary line, which commences at the junction of the asphalted road leading to the community of Ormidhia with the Avgorou-Ormidhia-Akhna Forest road by the water reservoirs of the community of Ormidhia; thence in a northerly direction along the above main road, up to its junction with a village track, at a distance of about 1700m; thence in a westerly direction along the above village track, up to its junction with the Xylotymbou-Akhna road; thence, in a north-easterly direction along the above main road, up to Akhna Forest; thence in an easterly direction along the Akhna Forest-Ormidhia road, up to the eastern end of the built-up area of Akhna Forest; thence in an easterly direction along a village track, up to its junction with the village track of the livestock area of Akhna Forest; thence in a northerly direction along the above village track, up to its junction with the Akhna Forest-Avgorou road; thence in a consecutive south-easterly, north-easterly, northerly, and easterly direction along the above main road, up to the boundary of the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area; thence in a consecutive south-easterly and southerly direction along the above boundary, up to the Avgorou-Ormidhia road, and from there in a south-westerly direction along the above main road up to the point of commencement; all of which area is sign-posted on the ground.</p> <p>(ii) The area contained within the boundary line, which commences at the junction of the boundary of the Sovereign Base Areas (south of Boundary Pillar 17) with the village track Xylotymbou-livestock area Xylotymbou; thence in a south-easterly direction along the above village track, up to its junction with the village track leading from the Community of Ormidhia to the Ormidhia-Akhna Forest road at a distance of about 2250 m; thence consecutively in an easterly and south-easterly direction along the above village track, up its junction with a village track at a distance of about 1100m; thence in a south-westerly direction along the above village track for a distance of about 300m; thence in a north-westerly direction and a straight line up to the village track at a distance of about 1250m; thence in a north-westerly direction along the above village track near and to the north of the Ormidhia-Xylotymbou road, up to its junction with a village track to the south of the water reservoir of Xylotymbou village; thence in a southerly direction along the above village track, up to its junction with the Ormidhia-Xylotymbou road; thence in a north-westerly direction along the above road, up to the boundary of the British Bases eastwards of the Xylotymbou village, and thence in a northerly direction along the above boundary up to the point of commencement; all of which area is sign-posted on the ground.</p>	From 1 st January 2007 to 15 th August 2007 (both dates included).

	<p>(iii) Any areas which have been declared by Public Instruments, published in the Gazette from time to time, as permanent Game Reserves and have been appropriately sign-posted on the ground;</p> <p>The prescribed area is outlined in red on a map, under identification no. SBA/AO(D)/TGR(06-07), signed and sealed by me and deposited at the Area Office Dhekelia.</p>	
2.	<p>(a) The area contained within a boundary line, which commences at the junction of the asphalted road leading to the community of Ormidhia with the Avgorou-Ormidhia-Akhna Forest road by the water reservoirs of the community of Ormidhia; thence in a northerly direction along the above main road, up to its junction with a village track, at a distance of about 1700m; thence in a westerly direction along the above village track, up to its junction with the Xylotymbou-Akhna road; thence, in a north-easterly direction along the above main road, up to Akhna Forest; thence in an easterly direction along the Akhna Forest-Ormidhia road, up to the eastern end of the built-up area of Akhna Forest; thence in an easterly direction along a village track, up to its junction with the village track of the livestock area of Akhna Forest; thence in a northerly direction along the above village track, up to its junction with the Akhna Forest-Avgorou road; thence in a consecutive south-easterly, north-easterly, northerly, and easterly direction along the above main road, up to the boundary of the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area; thence in a consecutive south-easterly and southerly direction along the above boundary, up to the Avgorou-Ormidhia road, and from there in a south-westerly direction along the above main road up to the point of commencement; all of which area is sign-posted on the ground.</p> <p>(b) The area contained within the boundary line, which commences at the junction of the boundary of the Sovereign Base Areas (south of Boundary Pillar 17) with the village track Xylotymbou-livestock area Xylotymbou; thence in a south-easterly direction along the above village track, up to its junction with the village track leading from the Community of Ormidhia to the Ormidhia-Akhna Forest road at a distance of about 2250 m; thence consecutively in an easterly and south-easterly direction along the above village track, up its junction with a village track at a distance of about 1100m; thence in a south-westerly direction along the above village track for a distance of about 300m; thence in a north-westerly direction and a straight line up to the village track at a distance of about 1250m; thence in a north-westerly direction along the above village track near and to the north of the Ormidhia-Xylotymbou road, up to its junction with a village track to the south of the water reservoir of Xylotymbou village; thence in a southerly direction along the above village track, up to its junction with the Ormidhia-Xylotymbou road; thence in a north-westerly direction along the above road, up to the boundary of the British Bases eastwards of the Xylotymbou village, and thence in a northerly direction along the above boundary up to the point of commencement; all of which area is sign-posted on the ground.</p> <p>The prescribed areas are outlined in green on a map, under identification no. SBA/AO(D)/TGR(06-07), signed and sealed by me and deposited at the Area Office Dhekelia.</p>	<p>From 1st January 2007 to 2nd January 2007 (both dates included)er 2005;(both dates included), except 26th ;</p> <p>From 1st March 2007 to 15th August 2007 (both dates included).</p>
