Supplies and Services (Temporary Extension of Use of Second Observation Borehole at Kolossi) Order 2007

This Order is made in exercise of the powers conferred on the Administrator by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order 1946(a), as applied to and adapted in the Areas by the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia Order in Council 1960(b) and the Laws (Adaptation and Interpretation) (Consolidation and Extension) Ordinance 1968(c), and as continued in force by the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Ordinance(d).

The Administrator is satisfied that the land subject to this Order should continue to be used for military purposes for an additional period beyond the extension provided for in Public Instrument number 7 of 2005.

Accordingly the Administrator makes the following Order:-

Citation, commencement and expiry

- **1.** (1) This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Temporary Extension of Use of Second Observation Borehole at Kolossi) Order 2007.
 - (2) This Order comes into force on 3rd March 2007 and expires on 3rd March 2009.

Authorisation of continued use

- **2.** (1) This Order applies to the land set out in the Second Schedule to Public Instrument number 30 of 2003.
- (2) The use of the land for military purposes is authorised for a further period until and including 2nd March 2009, subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in that Public Instrument.

Revocation

3. Public Instrument number 7 of 2005 is revoked.
