**PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF GAME AND WILD BIRDS (PIGEON  
CULLING) (NO. 2) NOTIFICATION 2008**

---

In exercise of his powers under section 59(1) of the Protection and Management of Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2004(a), and having been advised under section 59(1A) by an environmental expert appointed by him that the damage being caused by stray pigeons is serious and that no other practical solution is available, the Chief Officer makes the following notification:-

**Citation and Commencement**

1. This notification may be cited as the Protection and Management of Game and Wild Birds (Pigeon Culling Notification) 2008 and comes into force on the day on which it is published in the Gazette.

**Permission to shoot, kill, capture or pursue stray pigeons**

2. (1) Subject to the condition specified at paragraph (2), the following Sovereign Base Areas Police Officers, each permitted to carry a shot gun during any close season on land within Sovereign Base Areas that is occupied by the Crown in any capacity or to which access is controlled and restricted by the Crown in any capacity, in order to shoot, kill, capture or pursue stray pigeons:
