**FIXED PENALTY (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES OF ORDINANCE)(NO.2) ORDER 2008**


---

The Administrator makes the following Order in exercise of his powers under section 9(2)(b) and (c) of the Fixed Penalty Ordinance 1998(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Fixed Penalty (Amendment of Schedules of Ordinance)(No.2) Order 2008 and comes into force on the day on which it is published in the Gazette.

**Amendment to the Second Schedule of the Fixed Penalty Ordinance 1998**

2. (1) The Second Schedule(b) to the Fixed Penalty Ordinance 1998 is amended as follows.

(2) After serial number 40, there is inserted—

“40A.	Using a hose pipe to wash pavements, roads, verandas, rails or motor vehicles	€85	Water Conservation (Special Measures) Ordinance 2000(c)	Section 2”.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This note is not part of the Order)**

1. This Explanatory Note relates to the Fixed Penalty (Amendment of Schedules of Ordinance) (No.2) Order 2008. It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Order. It does not form part of the Order, and is not a comprehensive description of the Order.
2. The Order amends the Fixed Penalty Ordinance 1998, by adding several offences to the Second Schedule. The Second Schedule lists offences falling within the jurisdiction of the SBA Police, the Area Officers and others for which a fixed penalty may be issued. Each “fixed penalty” in the Schedule refers to the maximum penalty that may be issued for that offence.
3. The offence under the Water Conservation (Special Measures) Ordinance 2000 was previously a fixed penalty offence of £30, such provision being made in the Ordinance itself. The offences under the Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2008 were previously compoundable offences under the Protection of Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2004, which is the predecessor to the Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2008.
