SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TEMPORARY EXTENSION OF USE OF BOREHOLE AT EPISKOPI) ORDER 2009

This Order is made exercising the powers conferred on the Administrator by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order 1946(a):

The Administrator is satisfied that the land subject to this Order should continue to be used for military purposes for an additional period beyond the extension provided for in Public Instrument number 2 of 2007:

Accordingly the Administrator makes the following Order:-

Citation, commencement and expiry

- **1.** (1) This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Temporary Extension of Use of Borehole at Episkopi) Order 2009.
 - (2) This Order comes into force on 6 February 2009 and expires on 5 February 2011.

Authorisation of continued use

- **2.** (1) This Order applies to the land set out in the Second Schedule to Public Instrument number 2 of 2005.
- (2) The use of the land for military purposes is authorised for a further period until and including 5 February 2011, subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the First Schedule to Public Instrument 2 of 2005.
