**BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREAS (DECLARATION) NOTICE 2009**

---

The Administrator makes the following Notice in exercise of the powers under section 2 of the Bombardment Range Areas Ordinance(a).

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1. (1) This Notice may be cited as the Bombardment Range Areas (Declaration) Notice 2009 and comes into force on the day it is published in the Gazette.

(2) In this Notice, latitudes and longitudes referred to are to be construed by reference to the World Geodetic System 1984 (WGS 84).

**Declaration of range**

2. (1) The area in the territorial waters of the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area centred on latitude 34° 58' .85 North, longitude 033° 44' .04 East for a radius of 500 metres is declared as a bombardment range area for the periods specified in paragraph (2).

(2) The periods specified are from 0600 hours to 1800 hours on—

- (a) 16 July 2009; and
- (b) 17 September 2009.

**Expiry of Notice**

3. This notice ceases to be in force on 17 September 2009 at 1800 hours.

1. This explanatory note relates to the Bombardment Range Areas (Declaration) Notice 2009. It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Notice. It does not form part of the Notice.
2. The Notice specifies an area where military training of a type described in section 2 of the Bombardment Range Areas Ordinance will take place on 16 July and 17 September 2009. The area in question is a sea area to the northeast of Watson's Mole in the Dhekelia Sovereign Base Area.
