
NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) ORDER 2009

The Administrator makes the following Order in exercise of the powers under section 3(2) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006(a).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Amendment of Schedule) Order 2009 and comes into force on the day it is published in the Gazette.

Amendment to the First Schedule (Controlled Drugs) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006

2. Paragraph 1 of Part II (Class B Drugs) of the First Schedule to the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006 is amended—

- (a) by inserting “1-Benzylpiperazine (BZP)” after “Amphetamine”;
- (b) by repealing “Levomethamfetamine” and replacing it with “Levomethamphetamine”
- (c) by inserting “m-Chlorophenyl-piperazine (m-CPP)” after “Levomethamphetamine”.

The Order amends the list of Class B drugs in the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006 by adding the substances 1-Benzylpiperazine (BZP) and m-Chlorophenyl-piperazine to the list of Class B drugs in paragraph 1 of Part II of the First Schedule to the Ordinance.
