
NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) ORDER 2010

The Administrator makes the following Order in exercise of the powers under section 3(2) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006(a).

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Amendment of Schedule) Order 2010 and comes into force on the day it is published in the Gazette.

(2) In this Order the “Ordinance” means the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006.

First Schedule (Controlled Drugs) of the Ordinance amended

2. (1) Paragraph 1 of Part I (Class A Drugs) of the First Schedule to the Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by repealing the words in the first column of the following table and inserting in their place the corresponding words in the second column of the table—

 - (v) 1-Methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid;
 - (vi) 2-Methyl-3-morpholino-1, 1-diphenylpropanecarboxylic acid; and
 - (vii) 4-Phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester.

with— (2) Part II (Class B Drugs) of the First Schedule to the Ordinance is repealed and replaced

2. Any stereoisometric form of a substance for the time being specified in paragraph 1.
3. Any salt of a substance for the time being specified in paragraph 1 or 2.

4. Any preparation or other product containing a substance or product for the time being specified in any of paragraphs 1 to 3 not being a preparation falling within paragraph 6 of Part I.”.

(3) Part III (Class C Drugs) of the First Schedule to the Ordinance is amended by inserting “Tramadol” after “Pentobarbital”.

Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Amendment of Schedule) Order 2009 revoked

3. The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Amendment of Schedule) Order 2009**(b)** is revoked.
