ANTIQUITIES (PROPOSED DECLARATION) NOTICE 2011

The Chief Officer issues the following Notice in exercise of the powers under section 6(2) of the Antiquities Ordinance 1975(a).

Citation commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Notice may be cited as the Antiquities (Proposed Declaration) Notice 2011 and comes into force on the day it is published in the Gazette.

(2) In this Notice, the “Ordinance” means the Antiquities Ordinance 1975.

Notice of proposed declaration

2. (1) The Administrator proposes to exercise the power in section 6(1)(a) of the Ordinance to declare by Order that—

- (a) the sites listed in Schedule 1 be ancient monuments added to Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Ordinance; and
- (b) the sites listed in Schedule 2 be ancient monuments added to Schedule 2 to the Ordinance.

(2) An Order referred to in paragraph (1) will be made no sooner than 1 month from the coming into force of this Notice.

(3) The sites listed in Schedule 1 and 2 are shown coloured red on 7 plans marked as specified in the relevant Schedule and are stamped by the Lands & Surveys Department of the Republic and dated 27 May 2011 and available for inspection at the Area Office Akrotiri during normal working hours.

(4) A person whose interests may be prejudicially affected by the making of the Order referred to in paragraph (1) may object to the making of that Order by lodging that objection to the Area Office Akrotiri.

Schedule 1

Sites to be added to Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Antiquities Ordinance 1975

(Article 2(1)(a))

1. The remains of a late Roman/early Christian settlement at the site of Shiliastasia shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/A (Sheet LIX, Plan 49, Plot 1);
2. The remains of a late Roman/early Christian settlement at the site of Arkosikia shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/A (Sheet LIX, Plan 49, Plot 1);
3. The remains of a late Roman/early Christian settlement at the site of Agios Markos shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/B (Sheet LVIII, Plan 55, Plot 1);
4. The remains of the early Christian basilica of Agia Iphigenia at the site of Agia Phinia shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/C (Sheet LVIII, Plan 62, Plot 2);
5. The remains of a Roman structure at the site of Vromonera 2 shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/D (Sheet LIX, Plan 41, Plot 2); and
6. The medieval bridge close to the Akrotiri Salt Lake shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/E (Sheet LVIII, Plan 30, Plot 33).

Schedule 2

Sites to be added to Schedule 2 to the Antiquities Ordinance 1975

(Article 2(1)(b))

1. The remains of the medieval channel named Ktista at the site of Lishina shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/F (Sheet LIX, Plan 33, Plot 9); and
2. The remains of an archaic sanctuary at the site of Anthropos shown on the plan marked SBA/AOA/AMD/2011/1/G (Sheet LVIII, Plan 48, Plot 14).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Notice)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Antiquities (Proposed Declaration) Notice 2011 (the “Notice”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Notice. It does not form part of the Notice.
2. The note should be read in conjunction with the Notice. It is not, and is not meant to be, a comprehensive description of the Notice. So when a part of the Notice does not seem to require any explanation or comment, none is given.
3. The Notice is made under section 6 of the Antiquities Ordinance 1975 (the “Ordinance”). The Notice is made in anticipation of making an Order under section 6(1) of the Ordinance.
4. An order may be made under section 6(1) of the Ordinance in relation to any site (or objects or buildings) of historic, architectural, traditional, artistic or archaeological interest. If an Order is made under section 6, the site in question becomes an ancient monument and is then subject to certain protections. For example section 10 of the Ordinance makes it an offence to destroy injure or deface an ancient monument.
5. An order under section 6(1) can be made in relation to sites owned by the Republic (by adding the site to Part 1 of Schedule 1), the Crown (by adding the site to Part 2 of Schedule 1) or by any other person (by adding the site to Schedule 2). Before an order is made under section 6(1) the Chief Officer is to publish a notice in the Gazette of the proposed intention to make such an Order.
6. The Notice lists 6 sites which it is proposed will be added to Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Ordinance and 2 sites which it is proposed will be added to Schedule 2 of the Ordinance.
7. Items 1 to 5 in Schedule 1 of the Notice are on forest land vested in the Crown within the RAF Akrotiri. Item 6 of Schedule 1 to the Notice is within the boundaries of a public road vested in the Crown. Items 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 of to the Notice are on private property owned by the Bishop of Kition and Bishop of Limassol respectively.
8. A person who wishes to object to the making of an Order under section 6(1) may send an objection to the area Office Akrotiri, the postal address of which is Area Office Akrotiri, Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri, B.F.P.O. 53.
