
**GAME AND WILD BIRDS
(HUNTING) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2014**

The Chief Officer makes the following Regulations in exercise of the power in section 17 of the Game and Wild Birds Ordinance 2008(a)

Citation, commencement and expiry

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds (Hunting) (Amendment) Regulations 2014.

(2) These Regulations come into force on 1 November 2014.

(3) These Regulations expire on 1 March 2015.

Amendment to Game and Wild Birds (Hunting) Regulations 2014

2. The Game and Wild Birds (Hunting) Regulations 2014(b) are amended in accordance with regulation 3.

Amendment to regulation 3 (maximum number of certain species)

3. Regulation 3(2)(a) is amended by omitting “2 hares” and substituting “1 hare”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Game and Wild Birds (Hunting) (Amendment) Regulations 2014 (“the Regulations”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Regulations, and does not form part of the Regulations.
2. The Regulations amend the Game and Wild Birds (Hunting) Regulations 2014 to provide that the maximum number of hares which may be hunted or possessed on any day is 1 hare.
