1. This explanatory note relates to the Criminal Procedure Ordinance 2016 (Code of Practice: Conditional Cautions) Order 2019 (“the Order”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Order. It does not form part of the Order.

2. The Order brings into force a code of practice in relation to conditional cautions. The code is issued under section 47F of the Criminal Procedure Ordinance 2016. The code sets out certain matters as to when conditional cautions may be given and the conditions that may be attached.
