Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Criminal Procedure (Code of Practice: Visual and Audio Recording of Interviews with Suspects) Order 2020.

Commencement

2. This Order comes into force on 1 April 2020.

3. The code of practice entitled “Visual and Audio Recording of Interviews with Suspects”(b) comes into force on 1 April 2020.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Criminal Procedure (Code of Practice: Visual and Audio Recording of Interviews with Suspects) Order 2020 (“the Order”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Order. It does not form part of the Order.

2. The Order brings into force a code of practice in relation to visual and audio recording of interviews with persons suspected of committing a criminal offence. The code is issued under section 13 of the Criminal Procedure Ordinance 2016. The code sets out procedure for visual and audio recording of interviews and certain related matters.
