
**AIR NAVIGATION (RUSSIA SANCTIONS)
(REVOCATION) DIRECTIONS 2022**

The Administrator makes the following Directions in exercise of the power conferred by article 68 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013(a)

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) These Directions may be cited as the Air Navigation (Russia Sanctions) (Revocation) Directions 2022.

(2) These Directions come into force on 28 May 2022.

Revocation of the Air Navigation (Russia Sanctions) Directions 2022

2. The Air Navigation (Russia Sanctions) Directions 2022(b) are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Directions)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Air Navigation (Russia Sanctions) (Revocation) Directions 2022 (“the Directions”). It has been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of the Directions. It does not form part of the Directions.

2. Direction 2 of the Directions revokes the Air Navigation (Russia Sanctions) Directions 2022 which prevent Russian aircraft from flying over or landing in the SBAs unless there is an immediate risk to the safety of the passengers or the plane. These prohibitions are now contained in the Russia (Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) (Amendment) Order 2022^(a).
