
**MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC
(MOTORWAY AND SPEED LIMITS) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER 2024**

The Chief Officer makes the following Order in exercise of the powers under section 4(3) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006(a).

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) (Amendment) Order 2024.

(2) This Order comes into force on 5 March 2024.

Amendment of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) Order 2008

2. In paragraph 2 of Schedule 5 (Speed limits fixed for other roads: Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area) to the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) Order 2008(b), before sub-paragraph (1) insert—

“(A1) Limassol to Paphos Road between grid references 827369 and 830367;”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

1. This explanatory note relates to the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) (Amendment) Order 2024 (“the Order”). It has been prepared by the office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser. It does not form part of the Order.

2. This note should be read in conjunction with the Order. It is not, and is not meant to be, a comprehensive description of the Order.

3. The Order is made by the Chief Officer under section 4(3) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Consolidation) Ordinance 2006, which confers powers to designate speed limits on roads. It amends the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Motorway and Speed Limits) Order 2008.

4. The Order changes the speed limit on the Limassol to Paphos Road (the B6) between the grid references specified in the Order, around the North and South Paramali housing estates, from 65 kilometres per hour to 50 kilometres per hour.
