

The Central African Republic (Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2014

The Central African Republic (Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2014 (SI 2014 No 1368) was made on 27 May 2014 and came into force on 24 June 2014. The Order gives effect in the Areas to sanctions imposed on the Central African Republic by United Nations Security Council resolutions 2127 (2013) of 5 December 2013 and 2134 (2014) of 28 January 2014. The Order also reflects the implementation of these sanctions by the European Union in Council Decisions 2013/798/CFSP and 2014/125/CFSP.

Article 12 of the Order requires the Administrator to publish a list of “designated persons” and “restricted goods”.

“Designated persons” are the persons, entities or bodies listed in Annex I to Council Regulation (EU) No. 224/2014 <http://eur-lex.europa.eu/legal-content/EN/TXT/HTML/?uri=CELEX:02014R0224-20140624&rid=1> adopted on 10 March 2014.

“Restricted goods” are:

- (a) the goods, software and technology specified in Schedule 2 to the Export Control Order 2008 (UK) ([link](#)); and
- (b) so far as not covered by paragraph (a), the goods, software and technology specified in the Common Military List of the European Union <http://eur-lex.europa.eu/LexUriServ/LexUriServ.do?uri=OJ:C:2012:085:0001:0036:EN:PDF> as amended from time to time.
