

The Iraq (Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2015
(SI 2015/1383)

The Iraq (Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2015 (SI 2015 No. 1383) was made on 10 June 2015 and came into force on 8 July 2015. The Order gives effect in the Areas to sanctions in respect of Iraq applied under Article 41 of the Charter of the United Nations, the Security Council of the United Nations.

The sanctions imposed include an arms embargo and an asset freeze against persons designated by the United Nations Sanctions Committee. The Order also contains a prohibition on the import or export of illegally removed Iraqi cultural property in the specified Overseas Territories.

Article 13 of the Order requires the Administrator to publish a list of “designated persons” and “restricted goods”.

“Restricted goods” are:

Restricted goods for the purposes of the Order are

- (a) the goods, software and technology specified in Schedule 2 to the Export Control Order 2008.
- (b) so far as not covered by paragraph (a), the goods, software and technology specified in the Common Military List of the European Union as amended from time to time. The Common Military List can be found at this link:
